3. Agendas – Topics of Discussion

• This committee has delegated authority and responsibilities from GFC as it relates to academic and non-academic misconduct, as it relates to the final stage of grade appeals, and as it relates to petitions and student appeals. The terms of reference were clarified, and it was confirmed that the SAC is not the body to conduct the hearings. The SAC would be critical in identification

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of issues related to student conduct and review the process and procedure. Recommendations for edits to the procedure would go to the Academic Policy Committee. It was noted that the current Student Conduct Procedure contains both the academic and non-academic misconduct and it was felt that, under a review, the procedure would be broken into two parts to aid students, faculty, and staff. The Student Conduct Work Group has been formed to address this in 2021-2022. At a future meeting, an annual report would be coming to the committee to review the stats on academic and non-academic misconduct.

 Committee reviews academic policy and/or procedure implications prior to recommendation by APC and approval by GFC. The committee received an overview of the three procedures the Academic Policy Committee are revising: Grading and Progression Procedure, Student Code of Conduct, and the Registration Procedure. In addition, the Sexual Violence Policy and Procedure are prioritized for a review for the 2021-2022 academic year.
