

COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN

SYMPTOMATIC CASE ON CAMPUS

Responding to Illness

If an individual has any symptoms associated with COVID-19 while on campus, they should inform Security immediately and complete the AHS COVID-19 Self Assessment tool or contact 811. The individual should follow the guidance provided from AHS.

If an individual becomes ill on campus:

- Notify Security immediately
 - o security@auarts.ca
 - 0 403-690-1451
- The individual must leave their work area / classroom / studio immediately and leave campus wearing a mask and following hand hygiene
- If individual is unable to leave campus immediately, Security will isolate them from others utilizing the first aid room - S346
- Security will assist the individual arrange transportation home
 - Drive themselves
 - Have a family member pick them up
 - AUArts arrange taxi service
- The individual is to follow the AHS guidance regarding self-isolation and testing
- Once the symptomatic individual has left campus, all areas the individual may have come in contact with will be cleaned and disinfected
- If two or more individuals have become symptomatic and have a known location link, AUArts will notify Alberta Health Services (811)
- The individual will not be permitted back on campus until they receive a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free

Security will generate an incident report and distribute to the appropriate individuals on campus.

SYMPTOMATIC CASE OFF-CAMPUS

If an individual has any symptoms associated with COVID-19 after being on campus, they should inform the Manager of HSSE immediately (ieff.meighen@auarts.ca) and complete the AHS COVID-19 Self Assessment tool or contact 811. The individual should follow the guidance provided from AHS.

• The individual will not be permitted back on campus until they receive a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free

INTERIM MEASURES FOR SYMPTOMATIC CASE ON OR OFF-CAMPUS

Isolation and Disinfecting

- HSE Team will determine the location of the individual reporting symptoms and will isolate the
 area (take out of service) for a period of 72 hours from the last occupancy to allow air filtration
 and cleaning.
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting will be completed by Facilities team following the AHS guidelines.

POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE ON CAMPUS

Notified of a Positive COVID-19 Case

In the event that an AUArts student, employee or contractor has notified the university, or AHS has contacted the university, regarding a positive COVID-19 case, the following steps will be taken:

- Notify the Manager of HSSE who will inform the HSE Team and RMT Chair
- If the individual is an employee, the Director of Human Resources will inform the department manager
- In the individual is a student, the Manager of HSSE will notify the VP Academic and Provost
- The individual will not be permitted back on campus until they receive a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free

Information Gathering

- HSE Team will track the location(s) the individual has visited on campus for the previous 72 hrs.
 This can be completed by using the tools available in a manner that respects the individual's
 privacy as per FOIP (schedules, card access, CCTV, and AUArts COVID-19 Access Screening
 Form)
- HSE Team will generate a list of names the individual may have come in contact with. The HSE
 Team will provide AHS this information when requested for contact tracing and notification of
 individuals on campus
- HSE Team will make recommendation to Cabinet through RMT regarding potential closure of affected zone(s) or all of campus. Factors considered:
 - Multiple positive COVID-19 cases
 - o The number of individuals they came into contact with
 - Number of locations visited
 - Amount of time spent on campus
- Further enhanced cleaning of the known areas the individual has visited will take place by the Facilities team as directed by AHS

Communication

 When appropriate, the university will notify the AUArts community of the positive COVID-19 case on campus through e-mail, website and the AUArts Safe App.
