JEWELLERY FUNDAMENTALS: COLD CONNECTIONS (CEJW-200)

Please bring note taking materials (pen, pencil, notebook/sketchbook) and come prepared the first day of class with a few sketches/ideas for the projects you want to make and/or samples of projects you want to finish during the Open Jewellery Studio. Your instructor will discuss specialized tools and supplies during the first class and provide an orientation to the Jewellery + Metals area.

All items in blue can be purchased from the AUArts Bookstore. The AUArts Bookstore is open Monday - Friday from 8 am - 4 pm. You will be able to access the Bookstore during open hours with your ID card. Alternatively, you can call to place your order (403) 284-7663 and do curbside or security office pickup.

Standard Safety Glasses
 OR
 Safety glasses that fit over prescription glasses

Mandatory: Safety glasses: CSA (Canadian Standards Association) Eye Protection while in the studio. CSA Eye Protection must have a CSA, UL, SIE, etc. (national accredited testing organization) label or mark showing that it has passed testing and been approved. Prescription eyeglasses or sunglasses are not "impact resistant"; students who wear prescription glasses or sunglasses will also need to wear protective eyewear on top.

- 20cm Three-Square (Triangle) Needle File, Cut 2 AND 20cm Half-Round Needle File, Cut 2 OR
- Needle file set
- Assortment of drill bits*
- Glue stick or Rubber Cement
- 1.5 2 mm ball burr*
- Emery paper coarse (320 grit, Wetodry brand)
- Emery paper medium (400 and 600 grit, Wetodry brand)
- Emery paper fine (800 grit, Wetodry brand, 1000 if you want extra fine polish)
- Wooden paint sticks for emery paper free from Paint Supply store (you will need 4 minimum)
- 1, 6" sheet of 18g copper
- Sheet metal and/or wire/tubing copper or silver (metal thickness will vary according to the project you choose, (i.e. 18 gauge for a bracelet, 20 gauge for a hair piece or pendant, or 22g for earrings) 20g or brass sheet 6" x 6".
 (PLEASE NOTE MATERIALS for PROJECTS, including RIVETS + LINKS are NOT included on this list and should be purchased AFTER your design has been approved by your instructor!)
- Saw blades 2/0
- Zipper baggie & soft cloth (to protect work in progress from scratching)
- Jeweller's saw frame 3"
- Large half round file, Swiss, Cut 1
- Cotton apron (you can purchase an AUArts one from the Bookstore or bring one from home)
- Tool box/something to carry your tools in (optional, please note you till need to take your tools home with you at the
 end of every class)
- Sharpie (medium or wide tip)
- Long steel tweezers
- Masking tape
- White printer paper
- Brass Brush



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*Please Note: you do not necessarily require all of these tools. Your instructor will go over all of the tools with you during your first class to help you determine which supplies to purchase.

Estimated Total Cost of Supplies: \$200.00 - \$300.00 depending on tool & metal choices

Tools that cannot be purchased at the AUArts Bookstore can be found through the suppliers listed below. Some tools, such as files, can also be found at places like Princess Auto or Lee Valley Tools, where prices may be lower. Please note that the total cost of supplies is approximate and subject to change due to fluctuations in the precious metal markets, and the value of our Canadian dollar.
