## Choosing Your First Year Courses

To help you get started in your first year course selection in the Bachelor of Design, we've prepared a quick guide to core courses that have been scheduled without conflicts. These are a great way to simplify the registration process – when using the registration system, you can enter the CRNs (course registration numbers) to get to the exact course section you need. If you're receiving transfer credit for any of the listed courses, you don't need to enrol in that course.

In the BDes, you can take up to five courses each term in your first year. You can take as few as three courses to be considered full-time – if you're planning on completing in four years, you'll want take the full five courses. There are ten courses required in the first year of the BDes Visual Communication Design majors:

Core Studio	DESN 101 - Design Foundations (offered Fall and Winter) DESN 102 - Colour Foundations (offered Fall and Winter) DESN 103 - Digital Foundations for Design (offered Winter only) DESN 104 - Drawing Foundations (offered Fall only)
School of Critical and Creative Studies (SCCS)	AHIS 100 – Themes in Modern and Contemporary Art & Visual Cultures (offered Winter only) AHIS 101 – Themes in Pre-Modern Art and Visual Cultures: Before 1789 (offered Fall only) CCST 100 – Introduction to Critical and Creative Studies (offered Fall and Winter) ENGL 100 – Writing for Critical and Creative Practices (offered Fall and Winter)
