

Ceramics: Soda Fire (CECR 205)

Some items can be purchased from the AUArts Bookstore. Call 403-284-7663 for availability and to place an order over the phone.

Required for first class:

- 1 box cone 6 clay. Durable mid-range stonewares or porcelains that vitrify at cone 6. Recommended Plainsman M340 or M370 but open to other durable clay bodies.
- Small sketchbook
- Pottery Tool Kit or equivalent tools. Available at AUArts or Ceramics Canada. Includes wooden rib, wooden knife, needle tool, ribbon tool, loop tool, wire clay cutter.
- Fettling knife
- Small Bucket, 4 L buckets available at AUArts Bookstore
- Apron, towel, or clothes that you don't mind getting dirty.

Required for remaining classes:

- Brushes for glazing, decoration – recommend a single bamboo brush, basic long handle acrylic brush about ¼”

Optional Supplies:

- Serrated metal rib
- P100 Respirator
- Nitrile Gloves

Additional Notes:

If you are unsure about the optional supplies you can wait until class starts and the instructor will explain them/why you might want to purchase them.
