The Vice-President Research and Academic Affairs, in consultation with Academic Executive, may recommend candidates for emeritus status to the President and CEO. The criteria for making the judgment will be based on the cumulative record of accomplishments as reflected in the nominee's curriculum vitae.

Eligibility

- (a) Retiring faculty after 10 years of permanent service.
- (b) AND the completion of a distinguished career as a teacher and practicing professional who has substantially contributed to the Alberta College of Art and Design (ACAD) and has achieved recognized standing in the art community.
- (c) OR the recipients of the Award of Excellence.
- (d) OR Canadians who have made an outstanding contribution to the visual arts and design fields and who can, upon receiving emeritus status, contribute to the Alberta College of Art and Design.

Privileges

Individuals holding Professor Emeritus status:

- (a) May use the ACAD Library.
- (b) Shall have their names listed on the ACAD's website.
- (c) May be invited from time to time to give lectures or contribute in other ways to the activities and development of ACAD.
- (d) Will have their names entered on all appropriate ACAD mailing and invitation lists.
- (e) May use the emeritus designation and title.
- (f) Business Cards.
- (g) Parking privileges when visiting ACAD

- (h) Special seating at Convocation Ceremony.
- (i) Individuals granted emeritus status may be granted access to ACAD's resources and services as if they were regular members of the academic staff, subject to such arrangements as may be made in individual cases, and at the sole discretion of the Vice-President Research and Academic Affairs.
